> Knowing Christ by Levi Sisemore

The goal of the Christian life is not really heaven, that's merely a "place." What makes heaven desirable, is not *where* it is, but *Who* is there. "If you have been raised up with Christ (in baptism), keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God" (Colossians 3:1).

A throne-room is only as magnificent as the king who rules it. What makes Heaven everything it should be is God Himself (Revelation 20:11; 21:1-4; 22-23).

Each Christian is to be "conformed to the image of God's Son" (Romans 8:29), for "we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ" (Ephesians 4:15). It is through this process of transformation into the likeness of Christ, that we truly come to know Him. Not just knowing about Him, but truly knowing Him.

Paul says there is nothing of any greater value to him than knowing Christ Jesus his Lord (Philippians 3:8). Intimacy with Jesus is not just worth "something," it's worth more than anything in this life. You and I will never value Christ appropriately unless we stack up the whole of our lives against the worth of knowing Him, identifying with Him, and becoming like Him.

In Philippians chapter three Paul gives several ways by which he comes to know Christ: ...by boasting in Christ, ...by considering former gains as losses, ...by gaining Christ, ...by being found in Him, ...by having faith in Him, ...by knowing the power of His resurrection, ...by sharing in His sufferings, and by becoming like Him.

Jesus prayed, "This is eternal life, *that they know you* the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent" (John 17:3). Knowing God is the equivalent of eternal life and that's why Paul focused in on his relationship with God the way he did.
