There is a prevalent idea in religious circles today that once a person inherits salvation they can never lose it. But is this a true concept found in the Bible? Let's examine the evidence in Scripture and see what writers led by God's Holy Spirit had to say.

In Galatians 5:4, the Apostle Paul writes, "You have been severed from Christ, you who are seeking to be justified by law; you have fallen from grace." This was written to those who had placed their faith in Christ and been baptized into Him. Paul reminds those who were mixing in parts of the old law with Christianity that they had fallen from God's grace. May we be aware of God's truth and not seek a relationship with God by blending the old law with Christ.

In Hebrews 2:1, we read, "We must pay closer attention to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away from it." This was written to people who had faith in Christ and had been baptized. The warning is to pay attention, so they don't drift away from salvation.

In James 5:19-20, James teaches that those who have placed their faith in Christ and been baptized can wander from the truth, and become spiritually dead, "My brethren, if any among you strays from the truth and one turns him back, let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save his soul from death and will cover a multitude of sins." James wrote to those who had placed their faith into Christ and were baptized into Him.

In 2 Peter 2:20-22, Peter gives a strong warning to born again believers, "When people escape from the wickedness of the world by knowing our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and then get tangled up and enslaved by sin again, they are worse off than before.
