Seeking God with All Your Heart

In Acts chapter eight God pulls Philip the evangelist away from a very successful revival so that he could teach one individual. Why?

I believe that God had a promise to keep from Jeremiah 29:11-14.

The Ethiopian God seeker gives us four reproducible traits that wholehearted seekers of God will do.

Acts 8:26-27, "As for Philip, an angel of the Lord said to him, "Go south down the desert road that runs from Jerusalem to Gaza." ²⁷ So he met the treasurer of Ethiopia, a eunuch of great authority under Candace, the queen of Ethiopia. He had gone to Jerusalem to worship."

The treasurer of Ethiopia traveled 1,100 difficult miles to worship God and will not get to enter the temple courts. He could only enter the Gentile and women's outer court and put his ear against the temple wall in hopes of hearing a few words from the inner court of the men.

Reproducible Trait: 1. True God seekers will sacrifice and do whatever it takes to get close to God.

Acts 8:28, "He was now returning. Seated in his carriage (chariot), he was reading aloud from the book of the prophet Isaiah."

This man studied the Bible on his own, not for an assignment or a requirement.

Reproducible Trait: 2. True God seekers study the Bible on their own.

Acts 8:35-38, "Philip told him the Good News about Jesus. ³⁶ As they rode along, they came to some water, and the eunuch said, "Look! There's some water! Why can't I be baptized?" ³⁸ He ordered the carriage to stop, and they went down into the water, and Philip baptized him."

The eunuch quickly did what God wanted him to do. He knew he needed water baptism, he saw water, and he immediately obeyed the good news, the gospel of Jesus Christ.

4. True God seekers quickly do what God says to do when they first discover what God wants.
