> Are You Open? by Jacob Evans

Sometimes I forget that it is a holiday and drive to the bank to deposit a needed check, only to see a sign on the door that reads "Closed." Frustrating. A few years ago, my wife and I were craving ice cream. We made the thirty-minute trek from our home to the nearest ice cream shop only to see that the neon sign that read "Open" was not lit up. They were closed. Disappointing.

On one occasion, my gas light came on during a stretch of the interstate where exits were few

and far between. As more and more mile markers swept by, I began to get nervous. When I came to the next exit, I got off and went to the nearest gas station. The sign on the door read, "We're Closed." Troubling.

Now, there is something that is far more frustrating, disappointing, and troubling than a closed bank, ice cream shop, or gas station, and that is a heart that is not open to God. What is the sign on the door of your heart saying to God? Open 24 hours? Or closed?

As you consider this, keep three things in mind:

**1.** God will not walk into the door of your life and be a part of it uninvited (Rev. 3:20).

2. Opening your heart up to God involves giving your entire life to God, not just a couple hours a week (Matt. 13:44-46, Rom. 6:5-14).

3. Once the door closes on your life or Jesus returns, you will not be able to exchange a closed sign for an open one (Luke 13:22-29).
