We have two terrier dogs that can be high strung at times. The other day after putting up groceries, I put the plastic bags onto the trash. Notice I said, "onto," and not "into," because the trash was already full. Of course, the dogs were in the kitchen under my feet and one of the bags on the trash pile sailed across the floor.

Both dogs jumped out of their skin in fear and rage while barking irrationally. But of course, they're not sane nor rational beings, they're terriers and very territorial. Anything that invades their space is met with severe anxiety, panic, and over-reaction.

Although I scalded them, I realized later that I act much the same way. Many things that invade my space, is met with severe anxiety, panic, and over-reaction. Life has a way of producing things that are out of my control that I never expect, invite, or want. So, how do you handle them? My dogs like to react with anxiety, fear, panic and barking madly.

Paul says in Philippians 4:6-7. "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." When life produces things out of your control, rather than choosing anxiety, panic, and over-reaction, prayer is the starting point for Christians. The peace of God is with the person that chooses to pray, rather than chooses to exemplify anxiety, fear, panic and "barking madly." Instead of making things worse and raising anxiety levels in those around you, God has the perfect prescription in Philippians 4:6-7, that guards hearts and minds. That's a great pill to swallow when anxiety, fear or panic tempt us to react with the lack of self-control.


