Moving Through Grief Community Workshop by Colquitt Nash

The Battle of Cold Harbor, May 31 – June 12, 1864, is remembered as one of the bloodiest of the Civil War. The night before the battle, Colonel Horace Porter, aide to Ulysses S. Grant was walking among the Union troops giving some final orders.

He came upon some men who had taken off their coats and were sewing something on them. Looking closely, he saw they were sewing strips of paper on the back of their coats on which were written their names and home addresses so their fates could be made known to their families.

Colonel Porter later would write, "Such courage is more than heroic, it is sublime." Those who grieve because of loss are not much different than these soldiers. Every day they go into the battle called "Life" and carry out the jobs they must do.

This is not to say that the grieving process is a lonely and dead-end journey. It is lonely only because the griever and those around them do not know how to help them go through the process and emerge on the other side with hope.

Losses and changes in life cause us to grieve each loss and change. Grief is an emotional experience that can last for months or years. Grief not only is one of the most common experiences of life, but also one of the most misunderstood.

Someone with whom you have contact this week may be experiencing grief in some measure. If so, I hope that you, and they, will join us on November 16<sup>th</sup> for a time to discuss, share, and encourage one another in this journey of grief. Please pray for this time together as I am praying for you and those who will attend. God bless.

Getting Comfortable with God's Love by Gavin Williams

1 John 4:18: "There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love." God's perfect love can heal you and bring renewed life, if you let it (vv. 13-15).
