The Author of Our Salvation

Hebrews 2:10, "It was fitting for Him in bringing many sons to glory, to perfect the author of their salvation through sufferings."

The word Author in Greek is defined as: the founder and leader, the head or chief.

When speaking of Jesus as the author of our salvation, it reflects the early Christian understanding of Jesus as the divine leader who brings believers into a new covenant relationship with God.

An article in the Greek Lexicon uses this imagery, "The author is the first one to go through a wilderness area filled with trees and rugged landscape. The author blazes a trail through uncharted paths, so those who come behind can have direction with confidence, and proceed forward on the correct trail.

The trail Christ made leads to salvation through embracing suffering and accepting pain. This is an accurate metaphor of what Christ did when He GAVE His body, and ALL of His blood.

We follow His blood, and that path leads to forgiveness of our sins.

The blood of Christ blazes the trail for us so we can enter into the blood covenant of Jesus Christ with God, and become sons and daughters of God.

Jesus identifies with us by becoming man. Now, that's totally opposite of the Greek thinking. Greek's thought of God as detached from mankind. But when Christianity entered this world, instead of the idea of detachment, it became an idea of identification and closeness.

That's why Hebrews 2:11 reads the way it does, "For both Jesus who sanctifies and those who are sanctified are all from one Father; for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren."

Through Christ's sufferings, He becomes a brother to those sanctified in His blood, that's a picture of family.

We make contact with the blood of Jesus, by reenacting and entering His death, burial, and resurrection through faith, repentance, and water baptism. You can read Romans 6:1-23 for the details. Read all of Romans chapter six and you will come to see that faith immersed in water baptism IS God's grace that results in sanctification and the outcome is eternal life.
