#### **Check Your Flight Pattern**

Birds tend to navigate in the air one of three ways:

- 1) By flapping. This is very labor intensive. It requires that the birds continuously beat their wings against the air to create lift. But if the bird stops flapping, it will very quickly fall to the ground.
- 2) By gliding. Gliders flap to a certain height, spread their wings, and glide for great distances. This is very energy efficient, but without any additional effort, they will eventually end up back on the earth.
- 3) By soaring. These are birds that can flap to certain heights and then take advantage of the wind and updrafts to stay in the air. If the conditions are right, an experienced bird can soar for an indefinite period of time. This, of course, is the most efficient of all. Very few birds are designed to operate this way.

So why the bird lesson? Because I've noticed Christians are like birds.

Some Christians are "flappers." They flap and flap and flap, but never seem to get very far off the ground in their Christianity. They eventually stop flapping and end up back in the world and its fleshly ways.

Some Christians are "gliders." They flap and reach good heights, but then start gliding and descending and never flap again to continue their separation from the world. They, too, end up back in the world.

Some Christians are "soarers." They find the updrafts of God's power through His Spirit, word, and will, and reach incredible spiritual heights. There, sustained by what God supplies, they remain separated from the world and its corruption. There, upheld by God, the cares of the world are not likely to bring them down. And there, they are at peace, joyfully soaring and serving the Lord. Christian, what is your flight pattern?

"But those who wait on the LORD Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint" (Isaiah 40:31).
