Paul Was...Are You?

Jesus chose Paul to preach the gospel to the Gentiles. Once fully converted and committed, Paul served God admirably (2 Tim. 4:7). In three successive verses in Romans 1, Paul shows us how to prepare ourselves to follow his example, as he followed Christ and taught the teachings of Jesus to others.

- 1. "I am a debtor" (Rom. 1:14). Paul knew he was under obligation to preach to the Gentiles. It wasn't an option for Paul to teach and preach, it was mandatory. Should it be any less for us? We are a part of the Great Commission which binds us to "preach the gospel to every creature" (Mark 16:15) and follow up by "teaching them to observe" everything Christ commanded (Matt. 28:20).
- 2. "I am ready" (Rom. 1:15). Paul was well prepared to share the gospel of Jesus Christ. How about us? Do we study the Scriptures so that we can boldly teach the truth of God's Word to others? Are you ready, willing, and able to teach the gospel among your friends, family, and congregational classes? (1 Pet. 3:15)?
- 3. "I am not ashamed" (Rom. 1:16). Paul unapologetically told others about the saving grace of God. Sadly, many today cower in fear at the thought of mentioning Bible truths to others. Are you as bold and courageous as the lion-hearted Paul in proclaiming the good news about Jesus Christ (2 Tim. 1:18)?

These three things worked for Paul and they still work for us today. Christ wants us to be active in our faith whether it's on the streets or in the church (I am a debtor), and if we are truly prepared to do it (I am ready), then we will have no problem teaching the gospel to others (I am not ashamed).
