Am I Good Enough?

Would you honestly say that at some point in your life, you've wrongly based your worth on your past experiences? Take a look at how Moses believed the lie: I'm not good enough.

In Exodus 4, God Himself called Moses to deliver His people. Moses replied in Exodus 4:10, *"Please, Lord, I've never been eloquent, neither recently nor in the past, nor since You have spoken to Your servant; for I am slow of speech and of tongue."*

In other words, Moses was saying, *"God, I'm not good enough to do this job."*

God spoke the truth to Moses, but what's interesting is that Moses' own sense of inadequacy spoke even louder. So God replied in Exodus 4:11-12, *"Who has made man's mouth? Or who makes him mute or deaf, or seeing or blind? Is it not I, the Lord? Now go, and I, even I, will be with your mouth, and teach you what you are to say."*

At this point, you'd think Moses would believe God because God's word settles it, and there's nothing to worry about! But in Exodus 4:13, Moses said, *"Please, Lord, now send the message by whomever You will."* Moses was saying, *"You don't get it God, I'm not good enough. You have to send someone else!"*

How many times have we thought to ourselves, *"Since I'm not good enough, I can't make a difference. Why even try? I'm always average. I fail at everything I do. I'm not good looking enough. I'm not talented enough. My body's not right. I'm inadequate in every way. I'm really not worthy to be loved, so why bother?"*

2 Corinthians 3:2-6, "You are our letter, written in our hearts, known and read by all men; being manifested that you are a letter of Christ, cared for by us, written not with ink but with the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of human hearts. Such confidence we have through Christ toward God.
