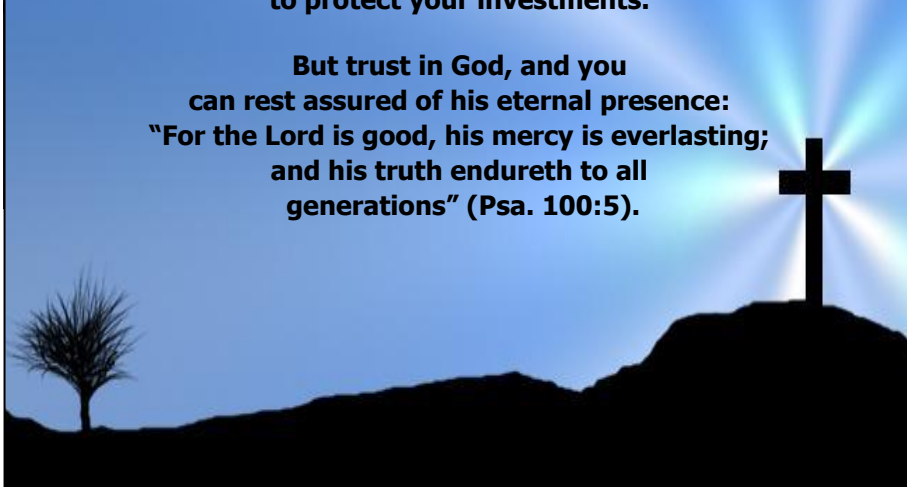
Trust in the Lord
