> What is Bearing Fruit? Author Unknown

Bearing fruit describes behavior that results from spiritual maturity. Gal. 5:6-24 contrasts the fruit of the flesh and the fruit of the Holy Spirit. In sin, we bear the fruit of jealousy, conflicts, and anger. The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness, self-control. Christians are to cultivate a meaningful relationship with God and demonstrate being made new in Christ.

Jesus said to abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. Bearing fruit requires abiding in Jesus.

When connected and intentional about our relationship with God, we produce the fruit God cultivates within us. As God works on us and in us, our fruit-bearing is a result of what He does. How do we build our relationship with God? We do things like spend time in His Word, pray and listen, worship God alone and with others, as we give of our time, money, and abilities. We actively pursue God and flee from sin.

Our focus is not the fruit we produce, but our connection with God. When we focus outwardly, we can become wrapped up in pretense. It's easy to live a Christian routine apart from a genuine connection to God. We can fall into the trap of putting on a holy facade without real heart transformation that is continual.

Bearing fruit is about intentionally growing in our walk with Christ, inviting the Holy Spirit's work of transformation in us, and actively obeying God in everything. As we seek Him and lay down our own fleshly desires for His kingdom ways, we will bear lasting fruit and serve as salt and light to a world in need of Jesus, as we encourage and lift up our brothers and sisters in Christ.
