> Beware of Satan's Nose and Foot by Edd Sterchi

The ancient Arabs had a saying: "Beware the camel's nose" which means that if we let one small undesirable situation occur, there would soon be a worsening to a disastrous predicament. If you let a camel get his nose into the tent, its whole body would soon be entirely in the tent. American's have a similar saying, don't let someone get "a foot in the door." Satan is no different. Like the bulky, smelly camel, Satan can inch into our lives, and given the opportunity he will lead us and fill our lives. Consider the following Scriptures:

• Eve (Gen. 3:1-6) – Eve allowed herself to doubt God's word and Satan inched in. Then she looked at the forbidden fruit, took it, ate it, and then gave it to her husband. She allowed just the tip of the nose of doubt into her mind, and before she knew it, Satan ruined her life and Adam and Eve both hid from the presence of God in fear.

• Achan (Josh. 7:1-26) – The people of Israel were forbidden to take any spoils of war. But Achan saw, coveted, took, and finally hid gold and silver that belonged to God. Satan got his foot in the door through theft, that led to deception, and eventually to the physical death of many.

• David (2 Sam. 11:1-27) – King David looked at a woman bathing, lusted, had an affair, tried to hide the sin, then murdered an innocent godly man. When sin gets a foothold, it grows. This also eventually led to more physical premature death.

May we be aware of Satan's temptations and realize that we can quickly be lead astray if we give him the opportunity. If we give Satan an inch, he will take a mile. "...do not give the devil an opportunity...so that no advantage would be taken of us by Satan, for we are not ignorant of his schemes" (Eph 4:27; 2 Cor. 2:11 NASB).
