This Confidence in Which We Trust

"What confidence is this in which you trust? You speak of plans and power but they are mere words. And in whom do you trust? Now look! You are trusting in the staff of this broken reed, Egypt, on which if a man leans, it will go into his hand and pierce it. But if you say to me, 'We trust in the Lord our God,' is it not He whose altars Hezekiah has taken away'?" 2 Kings 18:19-22

The Jews were warned that resistance will bring nothing but destruction. They're told they can't rely on Egypt to save them, nor rely on God. But in the next chapter, God sends His angel to the Assyrian camp and kills 185,000 men and the rest run away. The Jews were *able* to put their trust, faith, and confidence in the Lord.

The world puts confidence in physical things and it's useless because earthly treasures do not last. Over time, it will all be stolen or rot away (Matthew 6:19). Many have made fortunes and lost them when their countries fell to a foreign power, but if your trust is truly in God, it can't be shaken, no matter what happens.

The world puts its confidence in numbers. "You shall not follow a crowd to do evil" (Exodus 23:2). "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it" (Matthew 7:13). If you're putting your confidence in the fact that you're in a certain group of people, be warned that you are almost certainly going the wrong way!

Some put confidence in feelings. The religious world is notorious for doing what feels good, but Solomon says, "Its end is the way of death" (Proverbs 16:25). Jeremiah said, "The way of man is not in himself" (Jeremiah 10:23). What is the confidence in which you place your faith and trust? Is it in the Lord or somewhere else?
