Most of us are pretty good at making excuses and rationalizing as to why we are not more vocal in sharing the truth of the Gospel of Jesus with others.

In Amos 7:10-17, the Bible tells us about a time false teachers were seeking to silence the truth of God's message. Amaziah was a priest in Bethel and stood against Amos and his mission.
