I love listening to older, wiser folks than myself. I love history and learning it from people who loved it. I thank God for wise fathers who taught us what to do right. Even so, for those of us who had no good fatherly example in life, we learned what "not" to do. The following are some of the wise words and sayings I've heard in life:

- 1. When you hear a kind word spoken about a friend, pass it along (Proverbs 3:27; Galatians 6:10). If it's a negative word, keep it to yourself.

Mirror yourself continually in the opinion of others. Listen greedily to what people say about you. Expect to be appreciated. Be suspicious. Be jealous and envious. Be sensitive and never forgive. Trust nobody but yourself. Sulk if people are not grateful to you for favors shown them. Never forget a service you have rendered. Avoid your duties and responsibilities if you can. Do as little as possible for others."
