> The Fulfillment of the Law by Rob Toornstra

Matthew 5:17, "Do not think that I came to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I did not come to abolish but to fulfill."

Two spiritual poisons are deadly to the soul. The first is the belief that God loves and accepts us because of our performance. We ingest this toxin when we look at our own history of good behavior and think that's why God loves us.

The second spiritual poison says we are free to live however we wish because God's love is not based on our good works. We ingest this toxin anytime we brush aside the importance of obedience or minimize some sin in our life.

Jesus warns against both. To those who insist that God's law is unimportant, Jesus says he has come to obey God's law perfectly. Obedience to God matters so much that Jesus had to keep God's commandments perfectly, fulfilling the law, so that we might have salvation.

At the same time, Jesus warns in Matthew 5:20, that if we try to gain God's approval based on our moral performance, our righteousness must surpass that of the scribes and Pharisees. They were religious experts famous for obedience to the law, yet they could not enter the kingdom of heaven.

The good news is that although we cannot obey God's law, Jesus fulfilled it for us. Then he was punished for our sake as a law-breaker so that God might view us as law-keepers! As the gospel lives in us, may we live a life of obedience that flows from gratitude to Jesus.
