Who is Jesus? September 29, 2021

Matthew 16:13-17, "When Jesus came into the district of Caesarea Philippi, He was asking His disciples, "Who do people say that the Son of Man is?" ¹⁴ And they said, "Some say John the Baptist; and others, Elijah; but still others, Jeremiah, or one of the prophets." ¹⁵ He said to them, "But who do you say that I am?" ¹⁶ Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." ¹⁷ And Jesus said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Barjona, because flesh and blood did not reveal this to you, but My Father who is in heaven."

Jesus asked two foundational questions in this passage:

1. Who do people say that I am?

John 4:25-26, "I know that Messiah is coming." And Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am He."

John 8:56-58, "Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw it and was glad." You are not yet fifty years old, and have you seen Abraham? Truly, truly, I say to you, before Abraham was born, I am."

John 14:6, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life."

John 5:21, "The Son gives life to whom He wishes."

John 8:52, "If anyone keeps My word, he shall never taste of death."

John 8:29, "I always do the things that are pleasing to God."

John 8:46, "Can any of you prove me guilty of sin?"

Matthew 9:2, "Your sins are forgiven,"

Mark 2:7, "Who can forgive sins but God alone?"

John 14:9, "He who has seen Me has seen the Father."

John 10:30, "I and the Father are one."

2. Who do you say that I am?
