## Choices of True Faith September 22, 2019

**Hebrews 11:24-26,** "By faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter, choosing rather to endure ill-treatment with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin, considering the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures of Egypt; for he was looking to the reward."

## Moses chose to suffer in at least three ways:

1. Moses chose to suffer rejection and misunderstanding from his adoptive family.

**Acts 7:22,** "Moses was educated in all the learning of the Egyptians, and he was a man of power in words and deeds."

- 2. Moses chose to suffer by voluntarily forfeiting worldly prosperity, prominence and pleasures.
- 3. Moses chose to suffer by accepting the world's disapproval and verbal abuse.

**Matthew 13:45-46,** "The kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking fine pearls, and upon finding one pearl of great value, he went and sold all that he had and bought it."

## Moses received as least three blessings for his choices:

- 1. Moses received the blessing of God's people.
- 2. Moses gained the blessing of the greater riches of Christ.
- 3. Moses gained the blessing of the eternal reward in heaven.
