**Exodus 20:3-5,** "You shall have no other gods before Me. "You shall not make for yourself an idol, or any likeness of what is in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the water under the earth. You shall not worship them or serve them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, on the third and the fourth generations of those who hate Me."

**Deuteronomy 4:23-24,** "So watch yourselves, that you do not forget the covenant of the Lord your God which He made with you, and make for yourselves a graven image in the form of anything against which the Lord your God has commanded you. For the Lord your God is a consuming fire, a jealous God."

**Exodus 34:14,** "You shall not worship any other god, for the Lord, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God."

**Joshua 23:16,** "When you transgress the covenant of the Lord your God, which He commanded you, and go and serve other gods and bow down to them, then the anger of the Lord will burn against you, and you will perish quickly from off the good land which He has given you."

He who loves his life loses it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it to life eternal. If anyone serves Me, he must follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also; if anyone serves Me, the Father will honor him."

**Joshua 24:14-15,** "Fear the Lord and serve Him in sincerity and truth; and put away the gods which your fathers served beyond the River and in Egypt, and serve the Lord. If it is disagreeable in your sight to serve the Lord, choose for yourselves today whom you will serve: whether the gods which your fathers served which were beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you are living; but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord."

**Joshua 24:16-18,** "The people answered and said, "Far be it from us that we should forsake the Lord to serve other gods; <sup>17</sup> for the Lord our God is He who brought us and our fathers up out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage, and who did these great signs in our sight and preserved us through all the way in which we went and among all the peoples through whose midst we passed. <sup>18</sup> The Lord drove out from before us all the peoples, even the Amorites who lived in the land. We also will serve the Lord, for He is our God."

**Joshua 24:19-24,** "Then Joshua said to the people, "You will not be able to serve the Lord, for He is a holy God. He is a jealous God; He will not forgive your transgression or your sins. <sup>20</sup> If

you forsake the Lord and serve foreign gods, then He will turn and do you harm and consume you after He has done good to you." <sup>21</sup> The people said to Joshua, "No, but we will serve the Lord." <sup>22</sup> Joshua said to the people, "You are witnesses against yourselves that you have chosen for yourselves the Lord, to serve Him." And they said, "We are witnesses." <sup>23</sup> "Now therefore, put away the foreign gods which are in your midst, and incline your hearts to the Lord, the God of Israel." <sup>24</sup> The people said to Joshua, "We will serve the Lord our God and we will obey His voice."
