

The Role of Angels

Luke 15:7-10, *“I tell you, there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance. “Or what woman, having ten silver coins, if she loses one coin, does not light a lamp and sweep the house and seek diligently until she finds it? And when she has found it, she calls together her friends and neighbors, saying, ‘Rejoice with me, for I have found the coin that I had lost.’ Just so, I tell you, there is joy before the angels of God over one sinner who repents.”*

Luke 20:34; 36, *“Jesus said, “The sons of this age...cannot die anymore, because they are equal to angels and are sons of God, being sons of the resurrection.”*

Hebrews 1:13-14, *“To which of the angels has the Lord ever said, “Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet?” Are they not all ministering spirits sent out to serve for the sake of those who are to inherit salvation?”*

Hebrews 13:2, *“Do not neglect to show hospitality to strangers, for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.”*

Matthew 12:24, *“It is only by Beelzebul, the prince of demons, that this man casts out demons.”*

Genesis 32:1-2, *“Jacob went on his way, and the angels of God met him. And when Jacob saw them he said, “This is God’s camp!”*

Genesis 16:10, *“The Angel of the Lord, also said to Sarah, “I will surely multiply your offspring so that they cannot be numbered for multitude.”*

Exodus 3:2, *“The angel of the Lord appeared to Moses in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush... Yet it was not consumed.”*

2 Corinthians 11:14, *“Satan disguises himself as an angel of light.”*

Revelation 5:11, *“I looked, and I heard around the throne and the living creatures and the elders the voice of many angels, numbering myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands.”*

Matthew 26:53, *“Do you think that I cannot appeal to my Father, and he will at once send me more than twelve legions of angels?”*

Matthew 13:41-43, *“The Son of Man will send his angels, and they will gather out of his kingdom all causes of sin and all law-breakers,⁴² and throw them into the fiery furnace. In that*

place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. ⁴³ Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. He who has ears, let him hear.”

Genesis 3:24, *“At the east of the garden of Eden the Lord God placed the cherubim and a flaming sword that turned every way to guard the way to the tree of life.”*

Exodus 25:22, *“There I will meet with you, and from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubim that are on the ark of the testimony.”*

Psalms 99:1, *“The Lord reigns... He sits enthroned upon the cherubim.”*

Isaiah 37:16, *“Enthroned above the cherubim, you are the God, you alone.”*

Psalms 18:10, *“The Lord rode on a cherub and flew; he came swiftly on the wings of the wind.”*

Isaiah 6:2-3; 6-7, *“Above him stood the seraphim. Each had six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. And one called to another and said: “Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of his glory!” Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a burning coal that he had taken with tongs from the altar. And he touched my mouth and said: “Behold, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for.”*

Ezekiel 1:5-6, *“They had a human likeness, but each had four faces, and each of them had four wings.”*

Daniel 10:13; 20-21, *“The prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me twenty-one days, but Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, for I was left there with the kings of Persia.”*

Daniel 12:1, *“Michael...stands guard over the sons of your people.”*

Jude 1:9, *“Michael the archangel...disputed with the devil and argued about the body of Moses.”*

Revelation 12:7-9, *“War rose in heaven, Michael and his angels fighting against the dragon. And the dragon and his angels fought back, but he was defeated, and there was no longer any place for them in heaven. And the great dragon was thrown down, that ancient serpent, who is called the devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world – he was thrown down to the earth, and his angels were thrown down with him.”*

1 Thessalonians 4:16, *“The Lord himself will descend from heaven with a cry of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first.”*
