<sup>10</sup> *All nations surrounded me; in the name of the Lord I will surely cut them off.* <sup>12</sup> *They surrounded me like bees; they were extinguished as a fire of thorns.* <sup>13</sup> *You pushed me violently so that I was falling, but the Lord helped me.* <sup>14</sup> *The Lord is my strength, my song, and He has become my salvation.*

<sup>15</sup> *The sound of joyful shouting and salvation is in the tents of the righteous.* <sup>17</sup> *I will not die, but live, and tell of the works of the Lord.* <sup>18</sup> *The Lord has disciplined me severely, but He has not given me over to death.* <sup>21</sup> *I shall give thanks to You, for You have answered me, and You have become my salvation.*

<sup>22</sup> *The stone which the builders rejected has become the chief corner stone.* <sup>23</sup> *This is the Lord's doing; it is marvelous in our eyes.* <sup>24</sup> *This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.* <sup>26</sup> *Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord.* <sup>27</sup> *The Lord is God, and He has given us light; bind the festival sacrifice with cords to the horns of the altar.* <sup>28</sup> *You are my God, and I give thanks to You.* <sup>29</sup> *Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; for His love endures forever.”*
