## Receptive to God's Grace December 24, 2023

**Luke 1:26-27,** "Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city in Galilee called Nazareth, <sup>27</sup> to a virgin engaged to a man whose name was Joseph, of the descendants of David; and the virgin's name was Mary."

**Luke 1:28,** "Gabriel said to Mary, "Greetings, favored one!"

- 1. Mary was on good terms with Gabriel
- 2. Mary was favored by God

Favored One: highly favored because one is receptive to God's grace

3. Mary was receptive to God's grace

**Luke 1:30,** "The angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary; for you have found favor with God."

**James 4:6,** "God gives grace to the humble."

**Luke 1:30-35;37-38,** "The angel said to her, "You will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name Him Jesus. <sup>32</sup> He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David; <sup>33</sup> and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and His kingdom will have no end. <sup>34</sup> Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I am a virgin?" <sup>35</sup> The angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; and for that reason the holy Child shall be called the Son of God. <sup>37</sup> For nothing will be impossible with God." <sup>38</sup> And Mary said, "Behold, the bondslave of the Lord; may it be done to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her."

**Philippians 2:8,** "He emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant... <sup>8</sup> Jesus humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross."

- 4. Mary humbled herself before the Lord in obedience
- 5. Mary was open to what the Lord wanted FOR her and FROM her
