## Are We All Born with a Sinful Nature? December 31, 2023

**Romans 5:1-2;6-8,** "Having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>2</sup> through whom also we have obtained our introduction by faith into this grace in which we stand; and we exult in hope of the glory of God.

<sup>6</sup> Christ died for the ungodly. <sup>7</sup> For one will hardly die for a righteous man; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die. <sup>8</sup> But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 5:12, "Just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, so death spread to all men, because all sinned."

The Main Point of Romans 5: The All-Sufficiency of Christ's Redemptive Work

**Romans 5:14,** "Death reigned over those who had not sinned in the likeness of the offence of Adam."

## **Three Types of Death:**

1. Physical Death: Genesis 2-3

2. Spiritual Death: Ephesians 2:1

3. Eternal Death: Revelation 20:10

Romans 5:12, "Death spread to all men."

**1 Corinthians 15:22,** "For as in Adam all die (decay), so also in Christ all will be made alive (the resurrection-body after physical death)."

**Romans 5:16;18-19,** "The judgment arose from one transgression resulting in condemnation. <sup>18</sup> Through one transgression there resulted condemnation to all men. <sup>19</sup> Through the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners."
