**2 Corinthians 5:15-17,** "Jesus died for all, so that they who live might no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose again on their behalf. <sup>16</sup> Therefore from now on we recognize no one according to the flesh; even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him in this way no longer. <sup>17</sup> Therefore if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come."

**John 12:43,** "They loved the approval of men rather than the approval of God."
