**Luke 1:52-53**, *“The Mighty One has brought down rulers from their thrones, and has exalted those who were humble. He has filled the hungry with good things; and sent away the rich empty handed.”*

**Luke 3:4-5**, *“Make ready the way of the Lord, make His paths straight. Every ravine will be filled, and every mountain will be brought low; the crooked will become straight, and rough roads smooth.”*

**Luke 5:30-32**, *“The Pharisees and their scribes began grumbling at Jesus’ disciples, saying, “Why do you eat and drink with the tax collectors and sinners?”<sup>31</sup> And Jesus answered and said to them, “It is not those who are well who need a physician, but those who are sick.<sup>32</sup> I have not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance.”*

**Luke 6:20-21**, *“Blessed are you who are poor, who hunger now, and who weep now.”*

**Luke 6:22**, *“Blessed are you when men hate you and insult you.”*

**1 Peter 4:16,19**, *“If anyone suffers as a Christian, he is not to be ashamed, but is to glorify God. Those who suffer according to the will of God shall entrust their souls to a faithful Creator in doing what is right.”*

**Luke 6:23**, *“Be glad in that day and leap for joy, for your reward is great in heaven.”*

**Luke 6:27-28**, *“I say to you who hear, love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.”*

**1 Corinthians 2:12-16**, *“We have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may know the things freely given to us by God, combining spiritual thoughts with spiritual words. A natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand, because they are spiritually appraised. But we have the mind of Christ.”*

**Luke 7:36-39**, “One of the Pharisees was requesting Jesus to dine with him, and He entered the Pharisee’s house and reclined at the table. <sup>37</sup> And there was a woman in the city who was a sinner; and when she learned that Jesus was in the Pharisee’s house, she brought an alabaster vial of perfume, <sup>38</sup> and standing behind Jesus at His feet, weeping, she began to wet His feet with her tears, and kept wiping them with the hair of her head, and kissing His feet and anointing them with the perfume. <sup>39</sup> Now when the Pharisee who had invited Jesus saw this, he said to himself, “If this man were a prophet He would know who and what sort of person this woman is who is touching Him, that she is a sinner.”

**Luke 8:1-3**, “Jesus began going around from one city and village to another, proclaiming and preaching the kingdom of God. The twelve were with Him, <sup>2</sup> and also some women who had been healed of evil spirits and sicknesses: Mary who was called Magdalene, from whom seven demons had gone out, <sup>3</sup> and Joanna the wife of Chuza, Herod’s steward, and Susanna, and many others who were contributing to their support out of their private means.”

**Luke 9:23**, “If anyone wishes to come after Me, he must deny himself, and take up his cross daily and follow Me.”

**Luke 12:30-31**, “All these things the nations of the world eagerly seek; but your Father knows that you need these things. <sup>31</sup> But seek His kingdom, and these things will be added to you.”

**Luke 18:18-23**, “A ruler questioned Jesus, saying, “What shall I do to inherit eternal life?” Jesus said, “One thing you still lack; sell all that you possess and distribute it to the poor, and you shall have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me.” <sup>23</sup> But when he heard these things, he became very sad, for he was extremely rich.”

**Luke 22:25-27**, “Jesus said, “The kings of the Gentiles lord it over them. <sup>26</sup> But it is not this way with you. <sup>27</sup> Who is greater, the one who reclines at the table or the one who serves? Is it not the one who reclines at the table? But I am among you as the one who serves.”
