Jesus the Name Above Every Name January 26, 2025

Numbers 6:22-27, "Then the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, ²³ "Speak to Aaron and to his sons, saying, 'Thus you shall bless the sons of Israel. You shall say to them: ²⁴ The Lord bless you, and keep you; ²⁵ the Lord make His face shine on you, and be gracious to you; ²⁶ the Lord lift up His countenance on you, and give you peace.' ²⁷ So they shall invoke My name on the sons of Israel, and I then will bless them."

Invoke: to put or to place something upon

Psalm 91:14-15, "Because he has loved Me, I will deliver him; I will set him securely on high, because he has known My name. ¹⁵ "He will call upon Me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble."

Exodus 20:7, "You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not leave him unpunished who takes His name in vain."

Vain: evil, idolatry, uselessness, you shall not take the name of the Lord your God in actions, words, or objects that are futile, deceptive, empty, or lacking in substance.

Philippians 2:6, that "Jesus existed in the form of God, (and Jesus) did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped."

Hebrews 1:3-4, "He (Jesus) is the radiance of His (God's) glory and the exact representation of His (God's) nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He (Jesus) had made purification of sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, ⁴ having become as much better than the angels, He (Jesus) has inherited a more excellent name than they (angels)."

Hebrews 7:22-27, "Jesus has become the guarantee of a better covenant. ²³ The former priests, on the one hand, existed in greater numbers because they were prevented by death from continuing, ²⁴ but Jesus, on the other hand, because He continues forever, holds His priesthood permanently. ²⁵ Therefore He is able to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them. ²⁶ It was fitting for us to have such a high priest, holy, innocent, undefiled, separated from sinners and exalted above the heavens; ²⁷ who does not need daily, like those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the sins of the people, because this He did once for all when He offered up Himself."

Hebrews 8:6, "Jesus has obtained a more excellent ministry, by as much as He is also the mediator of a better covenant, which has been enacted on better promises."

Acts 4:12, "There is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name under heaven that has been given among men by which we must be saved."

Acts 19:5, "They were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus."

Acts 2:38, "Peter said to them, "Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

1 Corinthians 6:11, "You were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God."

Romans 1:5, "We have received grace, for the sake of Jesus' name among all the nations."

2 Corinthians 3:3, "You are a letter of Christ, written not with ink but with the Spirit of the living God, on tablets of human hearts."

Acts 3:6,12,16, "Peter said, "I do not possess silver and gold, but what I do have I give to you: In the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene—walk!" 12 "Peter replied, "Men of Israel, why are you amazed at this, or why do you gaze at us, as if by our own power we made him walk? 16 On the basis of faith in His name, it is the name of Jesus which has strengthened this man whom you see and know."

Acts 5:40–41, "After calling the apostles in, they flogged them and ordered them not to speak in the name of Jesus, and then released them. ⁴¹ They went on their way rejoicing that they had been considered worthy to suffer shame for His name."

Acts 16:18, "Paul was greatly annoyed, and turned and said to the spirit, "I command you in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her!" And it came out at that very moment."

Acts 26:9, "I thought I had to do many things hostile to the name of Jesus of Nazareth."

Colossians 3:17, "Whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus."
