## A Heart of Wisdom January 29, 2025

**Ephesians 5:15-17,** "Be careful how you walk, not as unwise men but as wise, <sup>16</sup> making the most of your time, because the days are evil. <sup>17</sup> So then do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is."

Psalm 90:12, "Teach us to number our days, that we may present to You a heart of wisdom."

**Exodus 3:1-5,** "Now Moses was pasturing the flock of Jethro his father-in-law and he led the flock to the west side of the wilderness and came to Horeb, the mountain of God.<sup>2</sup> The angel of the Lord appeared to him in a blazing fire from the midst of a bush, yet the bush was not consumed.<sup>3</sup> So Moses said, "I must turn aside now and see this marvelous sight, why the bush is not burned up." <sup>4</sup> When the Lord saw that he turned aside to look, God called to him from the midst of the bush and said, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am." <sup>5</sup> Then He said, "Do not come near here; remove your sandals from your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground."

**Psalm 131:2,** "*I have composed and quieted my soul; like a weaned child rests against his mother, my soul is like a weaned child within me.*"

Composed: calm

Quieted: to be silent, to be still, to rest.

**Hebrews 4:6-7,9-16,** "Those who had good news preached to them failed to enter (God's rest) because of disobedience, <sup>7</sup> "Today if you hear His voice, do not harden your hearts." <sup>9</sup> There remains a Sabbath rest for the people of God. <sup>10</sup> The one who has entered God's rest has himself rested from his works, as God did from His. <sup>11</sup> Therefore let us be diligent to enter that rest, so that no one will fall, through following the same example of disobedience. <sup>12</sup> For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart. <sup>13</sup> And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are open and laid bare to the eyes of Him with whom we have to do. <sup>14</sup> Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. <sup>15</sup> For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin. <sup>16</sup> Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need."

Matthew 11:28, "Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest."
