The Two Resurrections April 20, 2025

Job 14:14, "Can the dead live again? If so, this would give me hope through all my years of struggle, and I would eagerly await the release of death."

Job 19:25-27, "As for me, I know that my Redeemer lives, and he will stand upon the earth at last. ²⁶ And after my body has decayed, yet in my body I will see God! ²⁷ I will see him for myself. Yes, I will see him with my own eyes. I am overwhelmed at the thought!"

Daniel 12:2, "Many of those who sleep in the dust of the ground will awake, these to everlasting life, but the others to disgrace and everlasting contempt."

John 5:28, "Don't be so surprised! Indeed, the time is coming when all who are in their tombs will hear the voice of God's Son."

John 5:29, *"They will rise again. Those who have done good will rise to experience eternal life, and those who have continued in evil will rise to experience judgment."*

1. Two Different Kinds of Life

Luke 16:19, "Jesus said, "There was a certain rich man who was splendidly clothed in purple and fine linen and who lived each day in luxury."

Luke 16:20-21, "At his gate lay a poor man named Lazarus who was covered with sores. ²¹ As Lazarus lay there longing for scraps from the rich man's table, the dogs would come and lick his open sores."

2. Two Different Kinds of Death

Luke 16:22, "The poor man died and was carried by the angels to sit beside Abraham at the heavenly banquet. The rich man also died and was buried."

3. Two Different Kinds of Resurrection

Luke 16:23-24, "He went to the place of the dead. There, in torment, he saw Abraham in the far distance with Lazarus at his side.²⁴ "The rich man shouted, 'Father Abraham, have some pity! Send Lazarus over here to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue. I am in anguish in these flames.""

Matthew 25:46, "And they will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous will go into eternal life."

Matthew 25:30, "*Now throw this useless servant into outer darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.*"

Revelation 22:5, "And there will be no night there—no need for lamps or sun—for the Lord God will shine on them. And they will reign forever and ever."

Revelation 21:4, "*He will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there will be no more death or sorrow or crying or pain. All these things are gone forever.*"
