

Jesus is Greater Than Moses

Hebrews 3:1, *“Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest of our confession.”*

Consider: to consider carefully and fully, to look at in a reflective manner, to fix one’s eyes and mind upon something

Consider Jesus:

1. The Apostle

2. The High Priest

Apostle: one who is sent with authority

Hebrews 3:2-4, *“Jesus was faithful to God who appointed Him, as Moses also was (faithful) in all God’s house. ³For Christ has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses, just as the builder of the house has more honor than the house. ⁴For every house is built by someone, but the builder of all things is God.”*

Hebrews 3:5-6, *“Now Moses was faithful in all His house as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken later; ⁶but Christ was faithful as a Son over His house—whose house we are, if we hold fast our confidence and the boast of our hope firm until the end.”*

Moses as a Faithful Servant: a minister giving willing and voluntary service

Ephesians 2:19-20, *“You are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are fellow citizens with the saints, and are of God’s household, ²⁰having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the corner stone.”*

1 Peter 2:5, *“You are being built up as a spiritual house for a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.”*

Remaining God’s House is Based on Two Conditions:

1. Hold on to Our Confidence

2. Retain Our Boast in Hope
